



## CARLOS I COOKIES POLICY

Use of Cookies and file activity.

OSBORNE may use cookies, either itself or through a third party engaged to provide the service, when Users browse the sites and web pages of the OSBORNE Website. Cookies are files sent to a browser by a web server in order to record the activity of a User on the Website.

The cookies used by the Website, or the third party acting on its behalf, are associated solely with an anonymous User and their computer and do not provide any of the User's personal information.

Which cookies do we use?

**First-party cookies:** These are sent to the User's browser from equipment or a domain managed by the publisher from whom the requested service is provided.

**Session cookies:** These types of cookies are designed to gather and store data while the User is accessing a web page.

**Analytical cookies:** These cookies are either handled by us or by third parties and allow us to count the number of users and obtain statistical measurements and analyses of how users use our website. To do this, we analyse when you browse on our Website with the aim of improving the range of products and services that we offer.

We use the following application to obtain and analyse information from your browser: Google Analytics:

This application has been developed by Google, which provides us the analysis service for our website audience.

This company can use this data to improve their own services and to offer services to other companies. You can learn about these other uses by clicking on the links provided.

This tool does not gather data on users' names or surnames or the postal address from which they connect. For example, this information relates to the number of pages visited, the language used, the social network where news about our company is published, the city where the IP address used by our visitors is located, the number of users visiting our Website, the frequency they visit or revisit our Website, the time spent browsing our site, and the browser, operating system or type of computer used to browse our Website.

We use this information to improve our Website, to detect new requirements and evaluate the improvements needed in order to offer you the best experience.

When they are authorised by the User, the information obtained from cookies will be used to send the User information, provide web-based services, to launch and tell the User about our campaigns and special offers, and to advertise our products on any media.

Thanks to cookies, our Website server, or third party acting in our name, can recognise the User's computer in order to make browsing easier and to allow registered Users, for example, to access areas, services, campaigns and competitions reserved exclusively for them without having to re-register each time they visit our Website. We also use these cookies to measure audience and traffic parameters, and to monitor progress and the number of entries.

When the User accepts cookies, the server used by the cookie can be seen. For more details, please consult the instructions of your web browser. The User can configure their browser to receive an on-screen alert when they receive cookies and to prevent them from being stored on their hard drive. In order to use our Website, the User does not have to permit the installation of cookies sent by us or by third parties acting on our behalf, although in such cases the User will have to register or log in every time they wish to access the site.



Likewise, our web servers will be able to automatically detect the User's IP address and domain name. All this information is recorded in a server activity log that can be processed later to obtain statistics on the number of pages printed, the number of visitors using our web services, etc. Nonetheless, the information contained in this log is anonymised to prevent Users computers from being identified.
